

DECLARATION OF DISSATISFACTION

*Presented April 14, 2009
American TEA Party, Franklin, PA*

We, the people, declare our dissatisfaction to the President and Congress and request the following:

REGARDING TAXES

- That personal and corporate taxes be reduced to encourage investment and entrepreneurial activity and that wasteful and unnecessary government spending be eliminated including the elimination of earmarks.*
- That the “Stimulus Plan” be drastically reduced in scope and cost.*
- That favorable tax treatment of charitable donations be protected.*

REGARDING FREE ENTERPRISE

- That government swiftly and completely remove itself from those activities traditionally carried out by private enterprise, allowing investors, business operators and health care providers freedom to operate as they see fit and to succeed or fail according to their decisions.*

REGARDING NATIONAL DEFENSE

- That the defense of our country and the support of our troops be given top budgetary priority, providing the needed tools required to keep our enemies from inflicting harm to the citizens of this great nation.*
- That the federal government protect our borders from illegal entry and that our laws be upheld in making legal immigrants citizens of this country.*

REGARDING THE CONSTITUTION

- That the Constitution and constitutional process be upheld in all matters of passing legislation, including adequate time for reading and debating important issues by our elected representatives, proper notice of meetings and observing fair and reasonable opportunities for voting. All members of Congress must certify that they have read completely all legislation before voting on same.*
